- 3. The resolution is not lower than 120 pixels/inch
- 4. The shorter side is not less than 750 pixels
- 5. The files are named as follows: BP name + number (i.e. EUCANET 01, EUCANET 02, etc.)
- 6. The package does not exceed 10MB
